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## Community Cultural Participation Program Grant Application Process

### Priorities

When the Harney County Cultural Coalition Board of Directors meet to review grant applications, the following guidance will be used to establish granting awards, as based on public feedback received by the Harney County Cultural Coalition's Planning Committee and discussed fully within the "Harney County Cultural Plan, February 2004" (available for review at the Harney County Library, or call Beth Coahran 541-589-1440).

1. Promote awareness of Harney County's arts, heritage, and humanities resources, unique opportunities, and events.
2. Coordinate the development of Harney County's arts, heritage, and humanities communities to stimulate cultural and economic vitality.
3. Aid in the creation and promotion of a venue for arts, heritage, and humanities events (does not include construction costs).
4. Include and inspire youth participation in all things art, heritage, and humanities.
5. Promote, sustain, and facilitate arts, heritage, and humanities leadership.
6. Support the excellence of current and future arts, humanities, and heritage endeavors.
7. Encourage financial investment in the arts, humanities, and heritage of Harney County.

### Grant Program Commitments

(The following list indicates criteria which will be expected from grant funding)

1. Provide to the Harney County Cultural Coalition Board of Directors a written report on the utilization of grant funds and the success of the proposed program implemented within one year from receipt of the grant funding.

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2. Identify the source of grant funds through use of Cultural Trust logos and titles in all published program media.
